- Proven experience in scientific work

Your tasks may include support in:

- Conducting literature and data search and creation of result summaries

The working hours are up to 31 hours per month (7h/week). Remuneration follows the standard pay-scale for student assistants at the University of Göttingen. The contract is initially set for a duration of four months with the possibility of an extension.
